#### **Morning Psalms**

Autumn 1	<b>Psalm 90:14</b>  <i>"Fill us each morning with your constant love, so that we may sing and be glad all our life."</i>
Autumn 2	<b>Psalm 143:8</b>  <i>"Remind me each morning of your constant love, for I put my trust in you. My prayers go up to you; show me the way I should go."</i>
Spring 1	<b>Psalm 88:13</b>  <i>"Lord, I call to you for help; every morning I pray to you."</i>  In this verse, the Psalmist calls to God every morning and asks Him for help. The Psalm can be used as a morning prayer to God for help in times of

	difficulty. It is equally a reminder that God will come through for you at your point of need.
Spring 2	<b>Psalm 139:18</b>  <i>"If I counted them, they would be more than the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you."</i>
Summer 1	<b>Psalm 5:3</b>  <i>"you hear my voice in the morning; at sunrise I offer my prayer and wait for your answer."</i>
Summer 2	<b>Psalm 46:5</b>  <i>"God is in that city, and it will never be destroyed; at early dawn he will come to its aid."</i>


